PRIMARY OBJECTIVE

Develops and maintains the aviation security department ensuring compliance with National and International regulations.

PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To maintain and publish security standards in co-operation with all other bodies. Policy and procedures must be clearly defined in the Operations Manual Part A and the Security Manual.
- Review and record company security incidents and occurrences and initiate investigations as appropriate. This will include the monitoring of trends.
- Evaluate security related material and publications within Arik Air, other airlines, institutions, government authorities, other relevant bodies to determine and supervise the distribution of such material to operational personnel.
- To evaluate and assess any security threat to Arik Air and implement any remedial action as necessary.
- Ensure that all company personnel are appropriately trained in all aspects of security relevant to their duties and areas of responsibility.
- To ensure effective implementation of security procedures by regular audits and inspections that meet NCAA and FAAN requirements.
- Establish and maintain any aircraft incidents procedure to ensure an effective response through training and testing of all personnel.
- Encourage submission of confidential security reports through the Security incident reporting scheme.
- To develop and maintain Industry contacts on matters relating to security through governing bodies and organizations such as IATA, ICAO, NCAA and FAAN.
- To represent Arik Air at national and international conferences and meetings on all matters relating to aviation security.
- Ensure performance plans and reviews, including training and development requirements are completed for direct reports.
- Perform other duties as appropriate and within competence as requested from time to time.
- Ensure all security personnel within the security department have undergone initial and periodic security background checks.
- Perform other duties as appropriate and within competence as requested from time to time.
- Develop, Maintain and control of the security program.

- Knowledge of advanced explosive and narcotics security screening equipment.
- Previous experience in a similar security role.
- Ability to multi-task and prioritise in a pressurised environment.
